Opportunity Program Contract

As a condition to my admission to the University of Mary Hardin-Baylor, I understand that I must meet the following stipulations of the Opportunity Program in order to continue enrollment at UMHB.

1. I agree to wait one academic year (2 long semesters) before declaring a major.
2. I will achieve a minimum grade point average of 1.8 during my first semester. If my cumulative GPA is below a 1.8, I will be placed on academic probation as outlined in the UMHB catalog.
3. During my first semester, I will enroll in no more than 14 hours.
4. Additionally, if my first semester GPA is below a 1.8, I will repeat all courses in which I received an "F" during the next long semester.
5. I will be advised by a Center for Academic Excellence(CAE) staff member and will commit to at least three meetings during each long semester with that staff member. I also agree to recommendations made by the CAE staff that may include tutoring and/or study hall hours.
6. I will attend a Fall Welcome seminar specifically designed for students in the Opportunity Program.
7. I understand that if I fail to meet one or more of the above requirements, I will not be permitted to continue enrollment at the University of Mary Hardin-Baylor during the next long semester unless otherwise approved by the CAE Staff. (To re-enroll, students must then meet the requirements for re-enrollment as stated in the UMHB catalog.)
